

CLICI – Italian language courses from March to June 2019

The CLICI – Centre for Italian language and culture of the University of Rome Tor Vergata organizes extensive Italian language courses (60 hours) for foreigners from March to June 2019.

Lessons will be held twice a week from 5 pm to 8 pm.

Students who attend 70% of the course will be given a certificate of attendance and will be admitted to the final exam. Those students, who pass the final exam, will receive a final grade certificate.

Courses are free for students enrolled at the University of Rome Tor Vergata.

All students have to register online and, except the absolute beginners, students who want to enroll are required to sit a placement test and an interview for language level assessment.

The placement test and the interview will be held at Scuola IaD – Macroarea di Scienze MM.FF.NN. – Via del Fontanile di Carcaricola snc (see the link: <http://www.scuolaiad.it/dovesiamo>) on the following dates:

January 24th

February 5th, 7th, 12th, 19th, 26th

Registration deadline is 19 February 2019. It is possible to register up to 7 days before the chosen exam date.
