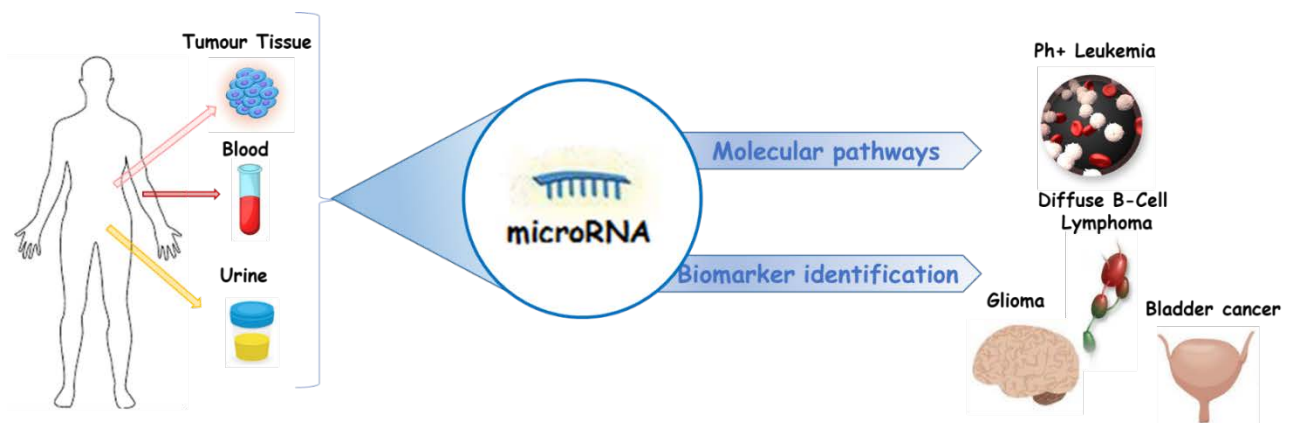




VACANT POSITION FOR MASTER DEGREE EXPERIMENTAL THESIS



Dr. Rizzo's research group (composed of 2 Post-docs and 1 PhD student) is involved in the study of circulating and tissue microRNAs in different kind of tumours.

In particular, there are four on-going projects:

- 1-serum microRNAs as non-invasive prognostic/predictive biomarkers in lymphoma patients (Marchesi et al, JECCR 2018)
- 2- serum microRNAs as non-invasive diagnostic biomarkers in glioma patients (Regazzo et al, JECCR 2016; AiPBAND European Project)
- 3-urine microRNAs as non-invasive diagnostic/prognostic biomarkers in non-muscle-invasive bladder cancer patients (Spagnuolo et al manuscript in preparation)
- 4-microRNA & MYB in Ph+ leukaemias (Spagnuolo et al, Hematologica 2019)
